## Reading (record book) - Please sign your child's reading record

Class Talks - To be introduced

Speaking and Listening is very important part of our Literacy curriculum. As part of our Speaking and Listening curriculum, each child throughout the year will be asked to prepare a little talk or 'show and tell'. This will involve choosing something from home that your child is prepared to bring into school and talk about.

In Key Stage 1 (foundation and years 1 and 2) this talk should only last about 1 to 2 minutes. The focus should be on interesting and important facts, whilst also making it personal. Question time will follow their talk.

In addition to this your child will be asked to recite a poem. This does not have to be learnt by heart at this stage unless they want to take on an extra challenge! However, please do encourage your child to recite the poem with expression.

Please help your child choose something of importance or interest to them.
